Aceh Culinary Festival

JULY 14-17, 2023

Banda Aceh City, Aceh

Samosir Music International

AUGUST 25-26, 2023

Samosir Regency, North Sumatra

Samosir Music International is a band festival coupled with Tortor performances and traditional music. At this event, singers and bands from Indonesia and abroad, both from Asia and Europe, perform their songs. Besides, they are also required to perform Batak songs in their respective musical genres.

Samosir Music Festival is also filled with panortor performances from various art groups throughout Samosir. Moreover, there are MSME stands serving culinary as well as craft and fashion MSME products.



Dieng Culture Festival

AUGUST 25-27, 2023

Banjarnegara Regency, Central Java

Dieng Culture Festival is an annual cultural festival that was first held in 2009. Combining natural beauty and artistic performances as well as historical and cultural local wisdom, this event was initiated by the Dieng Pandawa Tourism Awareness Group (Pokdarwis). The event also involves various elements of society, organizations, as well as local government.

In 2023, the event is held in the Dieng Kulon highlands, Banjarnegara Regency, Central Java Province. The iconic things from this event are the jazz performance above the clouds and the ritual of shaving the local children's dreadlocks. In addition, there are also other activities, namely Clean Dieng action, sky lanterns, and an exhibition of Dieng's local MSME superior products, which are expected to have a significant impact on the regional economy and the local community.





Kota Lama Festival

SEPTEMBER 7-17, 2023

Semarang City, Central Java



Kota Lama Festival is held to invite people around Kota Lama area and the City of Semarang to maintain and preserve Kota Lama so that it can become an ideal area that can be proclaimed for international tourism.

No one will be able to resist the beauty of the buildings in Kota Lama, which dwell a rich history of the development of the City of Semarang. In its 12th year, Kota Lama Festival takes the theme "Heritage in Harmony" and returns as a passage of time that reminds us of the unique cultural diversity of Semarang City, which has been acculturated and entrenched until now.

At this event, the visitors are invited to

reminisce on the past, see developments in the present, and together preserve all the rich heritage for the future. Some of the activities that have been prepared include wayang on the street, legendary culinary delights, MSME product exhibitions, orchestral performances, karawitan, fashion parades, Nyiur festivals, heritage conferences, Kota Lama explorations, and various other community activities.



Jember Fashion Carnaval

AUGUST 4-6, 2023

Jember Regency, East Java

Jember Fashion Carnaval (JFC) is a social event with a creative fashion concept packaged as a carnival parade. This event is held on the main roads of Jember City, starting from Central Park to the Sports Hall which is 3.6 km long. JFC aims to make Jember a trendsetting city of fashion and world carnivals. JFC participants come from Jember Regency and its surroundings, as well as other cities and provinces in Indonesia, with an age range from 3 to 70 years old, considering that there are several categories displayed at this event, namely Kids and Artwear Carnival, Wonderful Archipelago Carnaval Indonesia (WACI), and Grand Carnival. Apart from that, what is unique is the appearance of pets in this carnival.

National Reog Ponorogo Festival

AUGUST 14-18, 2023

Ponorogo Regency, East Java



The Reog Ponorogo National Festival is a traditional art that combines dance, bodybuilding skills, and Panji stories played by approximately 40 people, consisting of dancers, *pengrawit* (musical performers), and accompanists. The main attraction is that one of the dancers wears a headdress in the form of a tiger mask combined with a kind of crown made of peacock feathers which weighs approximately 40 kg in total. Interestingly, this headdress is strong enough to carry an adult human.



Imlek and Cap Go Meh Festival

JANUARY 20-FEBRUARY 6, 2023

Singkawang City, West Kalimantan



Imlek celebration, a Chinese tradition that is held based on the Lunar calendar, is an expression of gratitude to God and hopes for a good harvest in the upcoming year. Chinese New Year is always celebrated by the Chinese community in Singkawang every year. After Chinese New Year, the community continues the celebration of the traditional ritual of ward-off misfortune, Cap Go Meh, specifically on the 15th of the first month of the Chinese calendar

One of the unique things in the celebration of Chinese New Year and Cap Go Meh in Singkawang is the parade of Tatung attractions (people who have the ability to be entered by ancestral spirits or gods, also called saman). To watch their attractions, witness the way they honor their ancestors, and try their unique culinary delights, attend this celebration with us!



The "Gelar Melayu Serumpun" event is a gathering event to bring together Malay ethnicities from various regions and countries with other cultures. Activities with local wisdom art attractions are held as a means of tourism promotion in Medan City. This event involves several neighboring countries that have Malayan family ties and is attended by almost all regencies/cities throughout North Sumatra as well as several provinces in Indonesia. This year, the event brings the theme of "Takkan Melayu Hilang di Bumi" which translates to "Malay will never vanish from Earth."



Flower and Fruit Festival

JUNE 23-25, 2023

Karo Regency, North Sumatra

The Karo Flower and Fruit Festival has become an annual iconic event awaited by the people of Karo, especially North Sumatra. This festival can be considered Karo's identity, which is packaged in the form of exhibitions and performing arts involving many stakeholders.

In 2023, the Flower and Fruit Festival brings the theme "The Beauty of Karo". The theme highlights the beauty of Karo Regency through a carnival along the arterial road of Berastagi City. The carnival showcases cars decorated with various flowers from Karo Regency. During the event, there is 1 ton of free fruit-eating per day for visitors. Moreover, the stakeholders and various MSMEs will participate as tenants during the event"

Ulos and Fashion Festival 2023

JUNE 30-JULY 2, 2023

North Tapanuli Regency, North Sumatra



Ulos, or commonly known as shawl cloth, has been part of the Tapanuli Batak community since the 14th century. Ulos is usually worn as the official dress of kings and traditional leaders or is usually worn in Batak ritual events. In addition to its aesthetic value, a piece of ulos is also full of artistic, historical, religious, and cultural values. Ulos has the meaning of life and represents the universe. Ulos is also a symbol of blessing, affection, and unity. From motif, choice of color, type, to how to use and give ulos, all have their own meaning.

As an effort to restore the symbolic and sacred aspects of ulos in the life rites of the Batak people through exploring cultural values as well as educational and outreach efforts, created an event named Ulos and Fashion Festival. This festival also builds the capacity of weavers, individually and in communities, to create their own weaving ecosystem. The series of activities carried out at this festival include the Tenun Festival, Ulos Festival, Matumona Festival, Tourism Men's Selection, and Gowes de Sibandang II.

Bakar Tongkang Festival

The Bakar Tongkang Festival is a cultural event of barge burning to commemorate the arrival of the Chinese community at Bagan Siapiapi in 1820.



The burning of the replica of a large ship marks a hereditary tradition, with the climax of the event waiting for the mast to fall towards land or sea. It is believed to be a field for seeking sustenance in which direction the mast falls.

Before the burning of the large ship measuring up to 8.5 meters and weighing 400 kg, the ship is kept at the temple to be blessed and then carried in a procession (transported by a group of people) around the City of Bagan Siapiapi.

The festival also involves various communities that will strengthen the heritage theme in its implementation in the form of bazaars, exhibitions, and local art performances.

Tabut or The Ark is a multi-story building like a minaret, with various sizes and decorated with layers of colorful paper.



Tabut Procession has become a commercial festival since 1995 and is held with a series of colossal and entertaining activities for the people. In general, the implementation of the Tabut Festival is divided into 2, namely ritual processions carried out by the Bencoolen Ark Harmony Family (KKT) and festival contents carried out by the Bengkulu Provincial Tourism Office. This year, Tabut Festival is held on July 19-28.



Jogja Violin Fest

MARCH 10-11, 2023

Sleman Regency, Yogyakarta Special Region



The Jogja Violin Festival was held for the first time during the Covid-19 as a form of a campaign to keep being productive with various breakthroughs, innovations, and creations even in the middle of the pandemic. Jogja Violin Festival is a place for arts, culture, and event workers to show their talents. It also aims to promote Indonesian culture and tourism throughout the world, just like how W.R. Soepratman's violin played the national anthem (Indonesia Raya) for the first time during the Second Youth Congress in 1928.

In this 4th performance, the Jogja Violin Festival carries the theme "Tala Aksawakya" (#Good Indonesia) and will be held in the Tebing Breksi Area, Sleman, Special Region of Yogyakarta to coincide with national music day. The series of festivals include workshops, violin competitions, bazaars, and MSME exhibitions. The festival is also going to be enlivened by Yogyakarta regional and national musicians from various genres who will then collaborate with violin instruments. Festival Van Der Wijck

JUNE 2-3, 2023

Sleman Regency, Yogyakarta Special Region



The Van der Wijck Ditch, which stretches for approximately 17 km, was built from 1909 to 1932 during the reign of Sultan Hamengku Buwono IX. It played a role in ensuring the availability of staple food for the people in the Special Region of Yogyakarta. The Van der Wijck Festival is held as an appreciation for the existence of this ditch and efforts to develop culture-based tourism as well as sustainable agriculture in the western region of Sleman Regency.

This festival is held of, by, and for the people. It is packed with shared joy, the spirit of mutual cooperation, and an agrarian culture that has developed in Yogyakarta in particular and Indonesia in general. Some of the agenda for the Van Der Wijck Festival 2023 are wiwitan,

harvest, floating markets, cultural parades/carnivals, local cultural performances, gejog mortar competitions, as well as photography and videography competitions. This festival invites the locals and visitors to participate in creative rice-based processed competitions, creative economic workshops (culinary, wellness, and agrarian culture), MSME bazaar, as well as a 5-km visiting walk. The Kerontjong Moeda Symphony Community brings this Keroncong Plesiran music performance to a tourist destination in the Yogyakarta area. The chosen location in a keroncong performance cannot be separated from the 3A concept (Amenities, Accessibility, and Attractions). It is expected that, apart from being a form of appreciation and preservation of keroncong music, it can also become a promotional platform for tourist destinations in Yogyakarta and have an impact on the economic sector in the region.

Keroncong Plesiran is a keroncong-themed music festival that presents groups from various cities in Indonesia and also presents national vocalists to join in the keroncong with Simphony Kerontjong Moeda. Besides that, visitors can also travel, refresh, and enjoy all the facilities in the tourist area. Visit Yogyakarta and witness the performance on August 5, 2023.







Sumonar

AUGUST 27-SEPTEMBER 9, 2023

Yogyakarta City, Yogyakarta Special Region

Sumonar is the first light art festival in Indonesia initiated by the Jogja Video Mapping Project (JVMP) and SAAB! Production. Sumonar started as several video mapping show programs in 2013 and became a festival in 2018. Sumonar 2023 holds an alternative light art festival to present works for national and international artists in a hybrid manner through the website sumonarfest.com. This year's Sumonar involves several national artists from Yogyakarta, Jakarta, Bogor, Bandung, Surabaya, Malang, and Denpasar. Apart from that, the event also invites international artists from several

countries, namely Chile, Germany, Thailand, Spain, Japan, Macau, Bulgaria, Poland, China, along with light artists from other countries. Interesting programs are held virtually by promoting technology as a new way to enjoy a festival. Every involvement in the program is a special attraction to get the potential diversity of visitors.



Wayang Jogja Night Carnival

OCTOBER 7, 2023

Yogyakarta City, Yogyakarta Special Region

Wayang Jogja Night Carnival (WJNC) is a leading tourism event of the City of Yogyakarta which is held to commemorate the Birthday of the City of Yogyakarta on October 7 each year. WJNC is known as a collaborative event between the Yogyakarta City Government with the community, which is held at night in Tugu Yogyakarta area. It features a carnival with the main content being performing arts and street art. All of the performers are residents of 14 Kemantren (sub-districts) with backgrounds of artists from various professions as well as university students. Until 2022, WJNC itself has been successfully held 7 times.





The 8th WJNC in 2023, with the theme "Pandawa Mahaseka", is held in the Tugu Yogyakarta area with various activities for visitors, including flash mobs, sketch competitions, and photography competitions. This year's WJNC brings out event innovations in the form of Road to WJNC accompanied by supporting events to enhance the visitor experience and expand the location of the event so that it is not concentrated in one point. Supporting participants in the WJNC include artists from 14 sub-districts in Yogyakarta City, creative economy stakeholders namely fostered MSMEs from related agencies, as well as local products from the City of Jogja.

Ngayogjazz

NOVEMBER 18, 2023

Sleman Regency, Yogyakarta Special Region

The Ngayogjazz event in 2023 still uses the rural area as the venue and involves villagers as stakeholders as well as work partners. About 5 to 6 stages are planned to be spread out in several places in the rural area for the performances. Traditional arts are displayed, either in collaboration or independently. Ngayogjazz 2023 also involves jazz communities from various cities in Indonesia. Apart from arts and culture, the educational side is still maintained at Ngayogjazz 2023 by holding several workshops, including music and artistic workshops, as well as workshops for backstage workers.







Economic movement is also encouraged at Ngayogjazz 2023 through the Jazz Market which accommodates the businesses of residents and surrounding MSMEs, as well as invites communities outside of music to get involved. Preparation for Ngayogjazz starts around February by finalizing the cooperation with the village that will be used as the venue. Aside from that, the process of cooperation with related supporting parties will continue to be finalized. Like the previous Ngayogjazz, visitors can watch it for free.

Rujak Uleg Festival

MAY 6, 2023

Surabaya City, East Java



The Rujak Uleg Festival is the largest *rujak* Indonesian traditional spicy fruit salad culinary festival which has become a routine agenda for the Surabaya City Government since 2004. This festival is attended by approximately one thousand participants who grind the *rujak* sauces together in unique costumes. The main attraction is the procession of grinding the rujak by the VIP invitees on the "Giant Stone Cobek" measuring 2.5 meters on the main stage. The main stage is also round in shape, resembling the rujak uleg mortar. This procession is joined by all participants and accompanied by traditional music.

All participants' rujak is contested and prizes are awarded to the 60 best presenters. After the judging process is complete, the rujak is distributed for free to the visitors. Apart from the attraction of the grinding rujak using unique costumes, this festival also features dozens of MSME booths and displays of various cultural arts that represent cultural acculturation in Surabaya as well as a fashion show parade using carnival attire, where 10 best fashion models are awarded prizes.



Nyobeng International Dayak Bidayuh Culture Festival in Hlibuei Village, Sebujit Hamlet, has become a tourism agenda in Bengkayang Regency - Indonesia - Malaysia Border which is held on June 15, every year. This ritual is carried out to honor the ancestral spirits of the forest and mountain dwellers, who are considered to have provided abundant sustenance and protected the population from threats of enemies and disease. This procession begins by washing the Kayaw skulls, amulets, and other heirlooms left buried by the ancestors in Rumah Baluk.

The Nyobeng Ritual invites the community around the village and their relatives who live far away (the Bidayuhs of Brunei and Sarawak, Malaysia). In this ritual, the guests are greeted in a traditional way by the elders and the Hlibuei community. The event is carried out with dance attractions, in which the visitors go around the village to the Baluk Traditional House as the center of the Nyobeng International Dayak Bidayuh Culture Festival.

The Isen Mulang Cultural Festival (FBIM) will be held on May 22-27, 2023, in Palangka Raya. FBIM began in 1993, which was the moment when the culture of the Central Kalimantan area was introduced, demonstrated, competed in, and became an interesting spectacle for the people of Central Kalimantan in particular and Indonesian society in general.

The festival was attended by representatives from 14 district and city governments throughout Central Kalimantan. The Isen Mulang Cultural Festival has an important meaning for the people of Central Kalimantan in an effort to preserve regional culture and



increase people's creativity without leaving the original culture of their respective regions. FBIM contains competition material that includes Cultural Carnival, Traditional Arts, Traditional Games, Traditional Sports, and Regional Cuisine for the Dayak people of Central Kalimantan.



Babukung Festival

AUGUST 7-9, 2023

Lamandau Regency, Central Kalimantan

The exoticism of Kalimantan culture can be seen in the variety of traditional dances. In Lamandau Regency, Central Kalimantan, for example, there is a traditional dance called Babukung.

Babukung is a traditional mask dance in the funeral rituals of the Dayak Tomun tribe. To cheer up relatives of the deceased, the Dayak Tomun people hand over aid in the form of agricultural produce while dancing in masks accompanied by traditional music. The masks used in this ritual are generally the characters of various animals, which symbolize the entities that carry the spirits to the afterlife. The masks are used so that the bereaved family does not know who provide assistance

and, therefore, does not need to feel indebted. The Dayak Tomun people firmly believe that providing assistance to those in need is something that does not need to be shown off. It must be a mere act of sincerity. This tradition is the main philosophy of Babubung's life. To celebrate this ritual, Babukung Festival is held. Visit Lamandau Regency on August 7-9, 2023 to witness this heart-touching festival.

Bringing the theme "Collaboration", this year's Musik Alam Fest invites all community partners, local government officials, and other stakeholders to collaborateinsynergy. The combination of Collaborative Music and closeness to North Kalimantan's nature is the main attraction of this festival. The event, which is held for two days on September 29 and 30, involves selected MSMEs representatives with MAF faces, a Camping Area that is open to participants from nature activists, Visual Arts, and the Arts Stage.

Iraw Tengkayu

OCTOBER 8, 2023

Tarakan City, North Kalimantan

In simple terms, Iraw Tengkayu can be interpreted as a sea party. Iraw Tengkayu is a ritual of the Tidung tribe in Tarakan City, namely throwing the Padaw Tuju Dulung (a boat heading towards the bow) into the sea. Inside the boat, there are foods as offerings to express gratitude to God Almighty for the sustenance obtained from marine products. Padaw Tuju Dulung means a boat with seven prows, which symbolizes the number of days in one week. This is a cycle that must be passed by fishermen of the Tidung tribe in their efforts to earn a living at sea.

The color of the lowest bow is red, the middle one is green, and the highest bow is yellow. This means that there is only one ruler of the universe: Allah, Glory Be to Him.

Before the main event, there is a 5-day Regional Culture Week, the Padaw Tuju Dulung Boat Cultural Parade, as well as performances of various regional cultures from all over Indonesia. This event is attended by the entire community, state-owned enterprises, regional-owned companies, all regional apparatus organizations in Tarakan City, as well as students and all the people of Tarakan City. There is also a colossal dance performance that involves 250 dancers, consisting of high school students from high schools and vocational schools in Tarakan City.



Gelar Adat Budaya Dumud

DECEMBER 9, 2023

Tarakan City, North Kalimantan



Etymologically, dumud means "land". The ritual of the Tidung Tribe community in Tarakan City is held as an expression of gratitude to God Almighty. The Dumud Cultural Customary Festival is an event for the meeting and the creation of culture and arts typical of the Tidung Tribe community in North Kalimantan. This festival displays various forms of arts and culinary of the traditional Tidung people, which is considered to be an "intangible cultural heritage" nearly extinct.

The series of festival events include the traditional Dumud cultural carnival and the Sukap Sungud performance, which features traditional Tidung dances, arts, and cultural performances by schools throughout Tarakan City. Kiwon Gengkasi or dindang bebuay Ya (Latif) a night of love featuring traditional lullaby songs to put children to sleep, berudod Mulud Nabi, Sumpur Asyrakal (mass haircuts for infants and toddlers), Bekerangan Gambus Bedindang, and Kiwon Bebingkai (night of gift/appreciation for Tidung Tribe Traditional Elders). Visit Tarakan City on December 9 to witness this event.

Banjarmasin Sasirangan Festival

MARCH 10-12, 2023

Banjarmasin City, South Kalimantan

Banjarmasin Sasirangan Festival is an event that promotes the traditional Sasirangan fabric product, which is held annually by the Banjarmasin City Government to encourage craftsmen to be more advanced, creative, and economically empowered. This event is an effort to realize the preservation of Sasirangan cloth as a cultural heritage. Besides, The Banjarmasin Sasirangan Festival is held to provide a space for appreciation by involving Banjarmasin's local Sasirangan entrepreneurs and is wrapped into a collaboration event, Sasirangan product exhibition, as well as a prestigious Fashion Show featuring a touch of craftworks created by national designers.

The Banjarmasin Sasirangan Festival is held every year on March 10-12 in the center of Banjarmasin City.





Saijaan Cultural Festival "Magic From The Sea"

JUNE 1-5, 2023

Kotabaru Regency, South Kalimantan

The Saijaan Cultural Festival "Magic From The Sea" (FBS # 2023) is a flagship event for Kotabaru Regency that highlights the heterogeneous cultural diversity and society's unity in the Saijaan motto, which means one word, one way, and one agreement.

This event has the theme "Kotabaru Gate of the Archipelago": a communal effort to develop tourism in Kotabaru Regency in preparation for welcoming the Archipelago's capital city by performing arts, cultural diversity of Kotabaru, collaborating on the development of the creative economy, empowering MSMEs, and improving the community's economy.

In addition to enjoying the beautiful views of Siring Laut tourist destinations, visitors can witness the exotic culture of the Bajau Kotabaru Tribe and its unique marine cultural wisdom. One of them is the Selamatan Leut ceremony "Magic From The Sea," a skill (Sang Sandro) of turning salty sea water into fresh water by simply sticking a customary stick (Ancak) in the sea. Another interesting attraction of the Bajau Samah Tribe is the Titi Tali Tradition, a performance of traditional Alahai music and a parade of ornamental Bajau fishing boats. The peak of the show is the breaking of the national record (MURI) "Bagedek Baimbai", which will feature shoulder movements attraction from the Kotabaru Japin Anak Delapan regional dance and performed by as many as 2023 dancers.



Loksado Festival

JULY 7-9, 2023

Hulu Sungai Selatan Regency, South Kalimantan



The Loksado Festival presents natural, cultural, and local wisdom tourism. The Loksado Festival is filled with nature tourism activities and local cultural art performances in the form of cultural attractions from the Meratus Dayak community. The peak of the event is Bamboo Rafting (Balanting), which involves wading through the rapids of the Amandit River on a bamboo raft.

The series of events at the Loksado Festival begins with the registration of participants and cultural arts attractions of the Dayak Loksado indigenous people. On the second day, a river tubing tour is carried out, wading through the upper reaches of the Amandit River. Then in the afternoon the Mahumbal Festival, which

is a traditional culinary attraction of the Meratus Dayak community, is held. The evening is filled with entertainment events. On the third day, the Amandit river rafting is carried out using bamboo rafting which is the highlight of the Loksado Festival.



Mesiwah Pare Gumboh

JULY 21-23, 2023

Balangan Regency, South Kalimantan

Mesiwah Pare is "Harvest Thanksgiving" carried out by the Dayak Deah community, which occupies the areas of Liyu Village and Gunung Riut Village, Halong Subdistrict, Balangan Kalimantan. Regency, South celebration is a mandatory traditional ritual held as a form of gratitude to the Creator and held every year after the individual harvest is finished. Then in 2019, it was initiated by the people of Liyu Village and Gunung Riut to be

implemented collectively, which they called "Gumboh" (together). Therefore the name of the procession was then called Mesiwah Pare Gumboh (MPG) by carrying out the spirit of cooperation and a strong awareness to maintain culture and make MPG a medium for cultural inheritance to the younger generation. This year's Mesiwah Pare Gumboh is held on July, 21-23.

Lom Plai Festival Balikpapan Fest



Lom Plai Festival

MAY 2, 2023

East Kutai Regency, East Kalimantan

The Lomplai celebration is a traditional ritual that has been carried out for generations since the formation of Nehas Liah Bing Village as a commemoration of Princess Long Diang Yung's sacrifice to save her people from starvation. At that time, there was a long drought which resulted in crop failure and famine. Then, Boq Diang Yung received a revelation from Boq EMTA (The Creator) that he must sacrifice his only daughter, Long Diang Yung, to save his people from starvation. With a heavy heart, Boq Diang Yung complied with the order from Boq EMTA.

When Princess Long Diang Yung was slaughtered as an offering, her blood flowed onto the ground, and strange things happened. The blood turned into rice plants which continued to increase to meet the needs of rice for its citizens. So Boq Diang swore an oath: the descendants of the Dayak Wehea must carry out Lomplai to commemorate and remember his daughter's sacrifice. Therefore, during the post-harvest of paddy fields, the Wehea Dayak people always carry out the traditional Lomplai ritual, which is held around March, April, and May based on the rising of the months in the Wehea calendar. This ritual is packaged as Lom Plai Festival.

Balikpapan Fest

Balikpapan Fest is an annual event held to commemorate Tourism Day. This event is implemented by local industry stakeholders who work professionally with an abundant of ideas and visions.

This year, 2023, will be the fourth Balikpapan Festival. This event has special features because it is not only lively but also elevates regional potential and positive values. 

It begins with the Yadnya Pakelem ceremony, which is a sincere offering ceremony to Dewa Baruna (God of the sea) as an expression of gratitude for all the blessings, and a prayer for salvation to all creatures in this world.

At the peak of the event, there is a collaborative performance of Cak Janger art which combines the sacred dance typical of Nusa Lembongan, namely the Sanghyang Dance. On the following day, there are a beach clean up, coral transplantation, *negul bulung* (seaweed nursery), zumba, cultural parade, traditional competitions, and music performances as well as an MSME exhibition every day from morning to night.

Pemuteran Bay Festival

NOVEMBER 16-18, 2023

Buleleng Regency, Bali



The community of Pemuteran Village is committed to establishing Pemuteran as an alternative tourism destination based on community empowerment and environmental conservation "ecotourism". One example of this commitment is carrying out environmental conservation activities like the Pemuteran Bay Festival. Pemuteran Bay Festival is open to the public. Visitors who come for 3–4 days are usually involved in reef gardening activities, which are broadcast live from under the sea. At this event, there are also a lot of other activities, such as a Pemuteran nature run, photo hunting, a fishing tournament, Surya Namaskara Yoga from the afternoon to the evening, various cultural performances, music, as well as culinary offerings.

The Pemuteran Bay Festival in 2023 is held in the Pemuteran Cultural Cape Area as a show-based festival center, workshops, and culinary delights. Meanwhile, reef gardening and other activities are held in the Pemuteran Bay conservation coastal area.

The community believes that the sea worm is the incarnation of Princess Mandalika's hair. As a form of respect, traditions are held every 20th day in the 10th month based on the Sasak calendar.







This festival involves three regencies, namely Banggai Laut Regency, Banggai Regency, and Banggai Islands Regency with the purpose of strengthening their sense of brotherhood. Malabot Tumbe means something that is the first or the beginning, that is a process of delivering and receiving maleo bird eggs, from the Batui indigenous people to Tomundo (king) Banggai in Banggai Laut. In addition, it is also accompanied by various kinds of supporting activities (festivals) in the form of regional special competitions related to the theme of the event.

The City of Wamena, also known as the Baliem Valley, acts as the center of the largest mountainous region in Papua, where five major tribes namely the Hubula Tribe (known as the Dani Tribe), the Lanny Tribe, the Yali Tribe, the Hubla Tribe, and the Ngalik Tribe "Nduga tribe" reside here.





In the past, it has been part of their culture for the people of Baliem Valley to protect their territory from other tribes, and at the same time, maintain the dignity of their territory as their ancestral heritage which could not be given to others. If something were to disturb this ancient heritage, then their patriotic spirit will kick in and they will be more than willing to sacrifice their body and soul to fight for it.

The theme for The 31st Baliem Valley Cultural Festival in 2023 is "Stringing Hearts and Knitting Love to Preserve Culture, as Your Identity". And this event will be presenting historical theatrics performances of the journey of the Hubula Tribe in the past. This is one of our way to explore, maintain and guard our customs and culture so they can be preserved.
