



## Monumen Nasional

The Special Capital Region of Jakarta (DKI Jakarta) is the capital of the Republic of Indonesia. This provincial-level city is the center of business, political and culture visible from the existence of various headquarters of state-owned enterprises, private companies and foreign companies.

The famous 132 meter memorial monument popularly known by public as Monas was established to commemorate Indonesian resistance and struggle to seize independence from the colonial government of Dutch East Indies. Constructed and built during Soekarno's presidency period, the Monument was crowned with gilded flames and surrounded by Indonesia's historical reliefs, gardens, ponds as well as several open fields. At the base of the monument you can also find Indonesian National History Museum. Make sure you pay a visit to the Independence Room where the Republic of Indonesia symbol of the state and independence is kept in reserve. An elevator is also available to bring you to the top of the monument to enjoy the panoramic view of the entire city.



### Nasi Uduk

Nasi uduk is a kind of food made from white rice which is mixed and steamed with coconut milk from coconut which is grated, and flavored with nutmeg, cinnamon, ginger lemongrass and pepper. Nasi uduk has a savory taste in the rice due to its cooking process which is mixed with coconut milk. Usually served with tempeorek, fried noodles, fried sambal (hot sauce) with potatoes, balado (spicy marinated) omelet or poached eggs, crackers or fried emping, and fried chicken.

## Old City Jakarta

The old town of Jakarta also known as old Batavia is designed in Dutch-European style equipped with fortress, city walls, and canals. In 1972, the old town of Jakarta was officially lined up as a heritage site devoted to preserve the city's architectural history. As an old city, the area is surrounded by interesting and historical places that retain the original architecture, such as Jakarta Kota Station, Jakarta Historical Museum, Puppet Museum, Arts and Ceramics Museum, Fatahillah Square, and many more. There are also ontel (bicycle rental service) available to ride around the old town area.



## Setu Babakan

Situated in Srengseng Sawah, Jagakarsa District of South Jakarta, Setu Babakan is an artificial lake that at the center of preservation Jakarta cultural heritage and today is known as Betawi Cultural Village. Lake as deep as 1 to 5 meters with an area of 30 hectares and the water comes from the Ciliwung River. In this cultural growing in the area and swan boat rides for those who want to explore the lake. An assortment of Betawi culinary are available for you to try at this tourism destination, like kerak telur, bir pletok, dodol Betawi, ulam rice, and many more. Apart from that various Betawi cultural arts and performances can also be seen here, start from Betawi traditional house until cultural show, like ondel-ondel, lenong, and tanjidor.



## Macan Island, A Thousand Island

The presence of Eco Resort Villages combined with a nature conservation concept that is offered by Macan Island, one of the islands situated in Seribu Islands. You need to book in advance to visit this exotic tourism destination as visitors is limited. Several type of lodging is available for your stay at this resort including the sunset hut, eco wood, red brick, drift wood, and tent that will accompany you to watch the stunning nature beauties. A variety of water sports activities that you can do here. While coral reefs will provide their own beauty under the sea. This island is made up of the Macan Besar Island which is the place to stay and the Macan Kecil Island (Macan Gundull Island) which is left untouched and without residents.

### Jakarta Fashion Week

First held in 2008, Jakarta Fashion Week (JFW) is one of Indonesia's largest annual fashion weeks. This event is a venue for fashion industry players to showcase the latest designs, styles and modes. The prominent Southeast Asia fashion week has the potential to usher the Indonesian fashion industry to gain access to the international market. The presence of journalists, buyers, photographers, stylists to appearances from international models at this fashion show make this event more popular. For a week, the eyes of the fashion lovers will be focused on this event to keep up with the latest upcoming style in fashion.



### Jakarta Marathon

This annual sports event held in Jakarta is Indonesia's first international marathon. In 2013, the first marathon race is held and continuously run every year at the last Sunday of October. This event is participated by runners from all over the world who compete to be the fastest in the following categories: Marathon, Half Marathon, 10K, 5K and Maratoonz (for children) with the National Monument as the start and finish spot of the race. The route goes through various tourist spots of Jakarta, such as the old town, Pasar Baru, Cathedral Church, Istiqlal Mosque, HI Roundabout, Pancoran Statue, Gelora Bung Karno Stadium and the grandeur of the skyscrapers of the capital.




### Jakarta International Java Jazz Festival
